## IMPORTANT: Senior students are to also check their subject information booklets for fee and equipment information.

All senior students (Years 11 & 12) are required to purchase a lever arch folder. They will need a hole punch, subject dividers, Reinforced A4 lined paper and plastic sleeves for each subject (avoid sleeves that are light-weight as they tend to rip), as well as any additional requirements stated above. It is expected that <u>all</u> senior students return to school Day 1 with their folder organised.
