Active Kids Program

From January 2018, the **NSW** Government will provide \$100 through a voucher system for parents/guardians/ carers to contribute to the cost of their children's participation in sport and active

recreation.

The voucher can be redeemed towards payment of membership or fees with an approved provider registered with the Active Kids program, each calendar year.

Eligibility for vouchers

All children aged 4.5 to 18 years old, enrolled in school from Kindergarten to Year 12, residing in NSW with a valid Australian Medicare card will be eligible for a voucher.

This includes students who are home-schooled or enrolled in secondary school education at TAFE NSW or equivalent.

Parents have until 31 December 2018 to claim and use their voucher.

NSW PREMIER'S SPORTING CHALLENGE STARTS WEEK 5

The NSW Premier's Sporting Challenge encourages students and staff over a 10 week period to participate in a broad range of sports and recreational pursuits to develop their understanding of the importance of sport and physical activity.

During the 10 week Challenge students and staff record their physical activity each day. Any daily physical activity which is moderate to vigorous in intensity can be accrued.

Award levels for the Challenge reflect a daily activity time commitment. Activities may include time spent in a broad range of sports during lunchtime, in school sport programs, class time, before or after school and on weekends.

At the conclusion of the Challenge each student will receive a certificate based on their classes overall effort.

Australian Physical Activity and Sedentary Behaviour Guidelines

Students aged 5-18 years should accumulate at least 60 minutes of moderate to vigorous intensity physical activity every day. In the Challenge, that equates to a GOLD Award.

Award	Daily Activity Time
Bronze	30 minutes per day
Silver	45 minutes per day
Gold	60 minutes per day
Diamond	80 minutes per day

A **BIG THANK YOU** to those parents who have volunteered their time in the School P&C canteen this term. Unfortunately though we are still very low on volunteer numbers.


The Coolah Central School canteen relies on the efforts of volunteers to ensure its continued operation.
