Next term we will be trialling a new way of communicating with parents. We will be using the Skoolbag App which will enable communication to be targeted to specific classes or year groups. We hope that this will provide more timely and relevant information for all parents and caregivers. We know many pre-school parents are already familiar with this. Please see instructions later in the newsletter for how to access Skoolbag. If anyone requires support with this our office staff are more than happy to assist. The plan is for day-to-day communication to be through this

app. Celebratory Newsletters outlining the successes of our students will be published 2-3 times per term. I'd like to remind parents that "No Stopping" signs have been placed on each side of the entrance to the school carpark. This is to provide a clear view of traffic on the road for people exiting the carpark. Parents and caregivers dropping off students to school will need to stop outside of these zones. Police have been enforcing this change.

1. From your Android device, ensure you have an account in the Google Play Store
