Welcome to Week 5B. I'm pleased to advise people that we have a new Aboriginal Education Officer, Donald Dundas, starting at the school shortly. Don will work on Mondays and Wednesdays and will work both in class, and in the playground, supporting all of our students.

At Coolah Central School we have 51 students who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander. To continue to support these students we are establishing an Aboriginal Education Team within the school. This team will work to improve the educational outcomes for all of our students and ensure that all students know about, understand and respect Aboriginal culture. Any community members interested in being a part of this team are invited to contact me at the school.

Entering School Grounds

Visitors (including parents, carers and volunteers) are not to enter the school grounds without first signing in at the administration office. Visitors are required to sign out when leaving the school grounds.

Visitors are not to enter the playground or go to the classrooms during class time, or at lunch or recess time. If they wish to bring their child's recess or lunch to school, it must be left at the office and delivery will be arranged.



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

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
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
