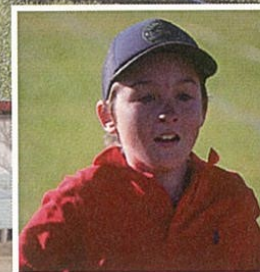
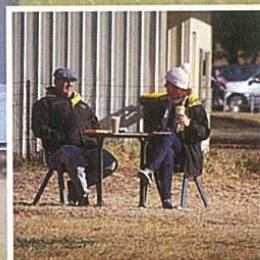
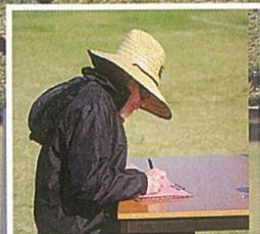
Cattle Club News
