

Principal's News with Mr Hughes

Welcome back to all students and staff. I hope everyone had a great Christmas holiday and is refreshed, ready for a great and exciting new year of learning ahead.

This past holiday period has seen large areas of our state devastated by bushfire. The impact of these fires does not just relate to the damage caused by flame and smoke, but importantly, it also has an emotional impact on us, our families and communities. I would like to remind you that Coolah Central School has supports in place for our students and families should they be affected. Please contact the school if required to discuss the support we can provide.

A reminder that the NSW Ministry of Health and NSW Department of Education have recommended that any student who was travelling in China (including Hong Kong) over the past 14 days should not return to school or child care services this week, as the coronavirus' incubation period can be as long as two weeks. Please advise the school if this affects your children.

We have a number of staff changes to let people know about.

Ms Lisa McDonald has been successful in gaining a substantive position teaching at Dunedoo Central School and Mrs Cheryl Rawlinson has taken extended sick leave. Mr Phil Jones has also left to the north coast. We are in the process of working with the Department of Education to find replacements for these teachers and hope to have our staffing settled for the year shortly.

Mrs Melissa Richard starts as Head Teacher Wellbeing and Mrs Rikki Esdaile will assist with some Learning and Support Teacher work.

For K-6 classes in 2020 we have again being successful in gaining government drought support to maintain our staffing numbers at our 2018 levels despite a fall in enrolments. As a result we still have six K-6 classes. Teachers and classes are:
